

SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT OUTSOURCING PROPOSAL

In what follows, the PROGRAMMER is the professional whom will win the current tender to convert the PRO Contact Manager from VB6 to DOTNET. The new system will be called ZAC, a registered trademark in the United States of America, as shown in the attachment "Certificate of Registration, United States Copyright Office, Library of Congress, Registration Number 528-704, Effective Date 15-Oct-1991"(1). This copyright document becomes an integral part of this tender. Violations of this copyright against the ZAC trademark or the source code for either ZAC or PRO (considered here as the precursor of ZAC) will be prosecuted according to the laws of the State of New York, in the forum of the city of Buffalo, N.Y.

The IDE will be Visual Basic 2008 and the database Microsoft Access 2007

The preferred programming language will be Visual Basic, but C# will also be considered.

In what follows, the AUTHOR is the legal owner of the ZAC trademark and the PRO source codes and the one paying the fees.

The process of conversion will be divided in PHASES, each PHASE in REVIEWS.

After every REVIEW, the AUTHOR will run the source files in a VB2008 environment, and qualify that performance meets specs, and if so, will proceed to transfer the amount specified for the given REVIEW to PROGRAMMER. If the AUTHOR detects deviations, corrective measures to bring design to specs will be performed via, either email or Skype, with the PROGRAMMER

Payment will be in US Dollars should the programmer be in India, or any other country. The assigned PROGRAMMER will fill a form including banking details for transfers to be effected. The Programmer will electronically sign a receipt for every completed REVIEW and email to AUTHOR after receipt of payment for the REVIEW.

The assigned PROGRAMMER and the AUTHOR, once an agreement is reached, will sign an agreement with is accompanying Copyright Document. All source code developed by the PROGRAMMER in every REVIEW will be the property of the AUTHOR, after payment of said REVIEW. Once signed, the AUTHOR or the PROGRAMMER can cancel this tender at any time after the last REVIEW, and its payment thereof.
